








Spirit Awakened 18"x24" Mixed Media on Canvas



Because my work is about energy and flow, no two pieces turn out alike, so if possible, I will create 2 paintings from which you can choose the one that connects with you best.





WORKSHOPS

I believe that a lot of us have lost touch with our creative side, and if we "exercise" that part of ourselves we don't just trigger the artist in us, but also the creative part that comes up with that "outside the box" thinking and opens our minds.

Sometimes artists get stuck in the details and "skill" part of painting that they have lost their inspiration, run out of ideas and have lost the joy they used to feel while painting. We get so busy following the rules of how we are "supposed" to paint, like it can only be done one way. I feel that in order to come up with new and original ideas we have to let go of the rules. I found that once I started to "play" with paint the ideas just started flowing! One fun result turns to something else and before you know it you discovered a style that is all your own!





I loved Greta's workshop! She packed a lot of creative experience into just a few hours. I have already applied some of the techniques to my own artwork. This workshop is great for anyone, whether new to art or an experienced artist looking for some new ideas. She explains things well and gives plenty of time to experiment and play, but moves forward in a timely manner so things don't get bogged down. 


